AUO has long been committed to green manufacturing and low-carbon transformation. Guided by international sustainability standards, the Company continuously strengthens supply chain resilience and its sustainable competitiveness.

In 2025, based on the second edition of the Sustainable Economic Activity Reference Guidelines published by the FSC at the end of 2024, AUO comprehensively reviewed and disclosed the sustainability attributes of its economic activities.

The Guidelines support Taiwan's 2050 net-zero emissions target. Through clear assessment principles, they help enterprises determine whether economic activities make a substantial contribution to six environmental objectives, including climate change mitigation and biodiversity conservation, while ensuring that no significant environmental or social harm is caused.
